Important information

After you reach age 67 (or over but under the age 75¹) we can only accept certain types of contributions if you meet the definition of gainful employment or are eligible to claim the work test exemption. Complete this form to make your declaration.
¹ Under age 75, means up to 28 days in the month after you turned 75. For the purpose of this measure if you turn 75 in April, you are considered to be under age 75 until 28 May.

Definition of gainful employment

The definition of being gainfully employed is being employed for at least 40 hours in a period of no more than 30 consecutive days in the financial year in which your contribution was made.

As an example only, if you undertook paid work on a part time basis, for 10 hours each week between 1 April to 30 April, you will have worked 40 hours in a 30 day period and will have met the definition of gainful employment.

3. You have not claimed the work test exemption in any prior financial year.
